



Setting up “Online Banking” using a smartphone/tablet

Step 1: Online banking contract



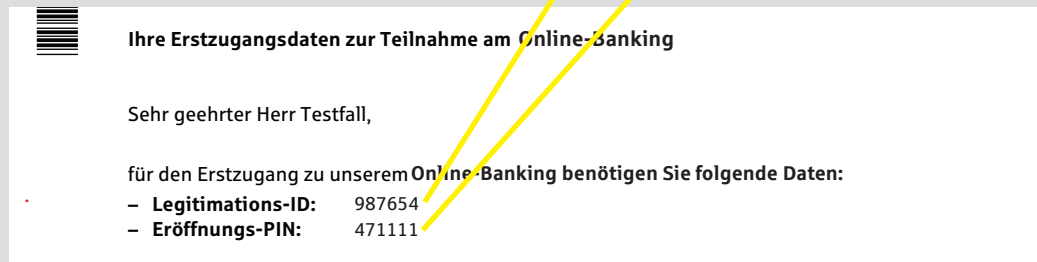
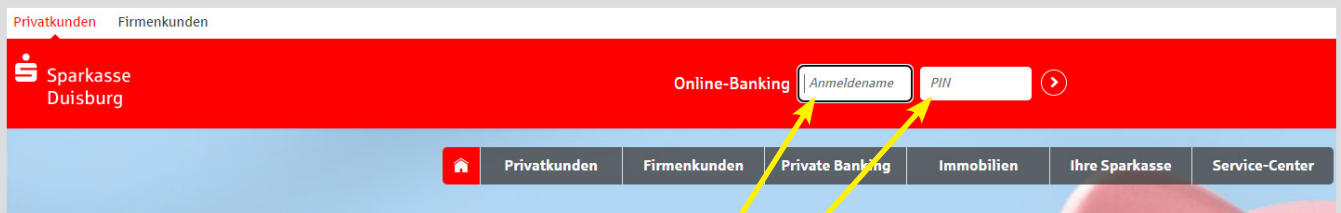
You have concluded the online banking contract in your local branch (or online).

You have received your personal login data to allow you to access your accounts: You can login to online banking with your Anmeldename (login name) (max. 15 characters, consisting of numbers and/or letters, special characters and spaces) and the Online-Banking-PIN (online banking PIN) (5 to 38 characters, consisting of numbers and/or letters, special characters and spaces).

Caution: In order to be able to use online banking, you also require **the S-pushTAN app**.

→ Continue to step 2

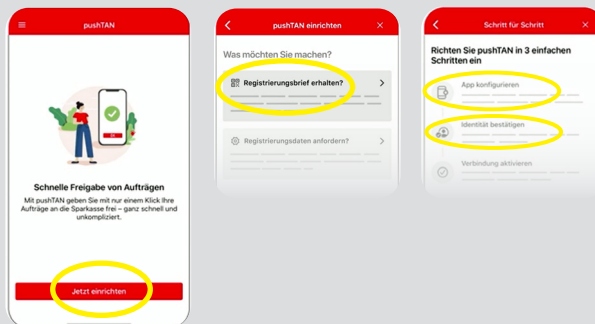
If you login to online banking from your PC or laptop, you do not require any other software. However, if you are using your tablet or smartphone, the “Sparkasse” app makes the process easier.



Step 2: “S-pushTAN” app



Start the app, assign a personal Password (password) (min. 8 characters, consisting of numbers, letters and special characters) and choose “Jetzt einrichten” (Set up now). → “Neu bei pushTAN?” (New to pushTAN?) → “Weiter” (Continue) → “Weiter” (Continue), to allow push notifications.



Ensure that you have created the following login data. You must make a note of these for later usage:

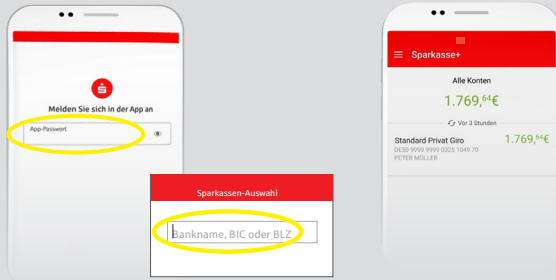
- Online banking: **Login name and online banking PIN**
- “S-pushTAN” app: **Password (set up touch ID/face ID if required)**

Optional

Step 3: "Sparkasse" app



Start the app. → Assign a personal **Passwort** (password) (min. 8 characters, consisting of numbers, letters and special characters) and enter the BLZ (bank code) 350 500 00. → Enter the login name and the PIN from your online banking contract. Your accounts are loaded automatically.



Ensure that you have created the following login data and also make a note of these for later usage:

→ "Sparkasse" app: **Password** (set up touch ID/face ID if required)
